Title: Dealing with excessive Internet use

Grade Level: 15-16 years old

Time: 60 min

- The students will understand what constitutes excessive Internet use and how it impacts their life.
- The students will develop strategies to regain a balanced life.
- They will practice critical thinking, teamwork, and public speaking skills.

# Description of the Lesson

Title	Time	Aim	Description of the Activity	Methods & Material
Introduction	10min.	To introduce the topic to the students and raise awareness around their Internet use.	<ul> <li>The teacher starts by asking the students about their Internet use. Some possible questions are:</li> <li>How often do you go online?</li> <li>How many hours do you spend online per week?</li> <li>Which websites or applications do you spend the most time on?</li> <li>Do you prefer to stay on your phone/computer rather than spend time with your friends/family?</li> </ul>	<ul><li>Methods</li><li>Questions and answers</li></ul>

Video Screening	5min.	To get a better understanding of the topic.	The teacher shows this video to the students	<ul> <li>Materials</li> <li>Computer</li> <li>Internet connection</li> <li>Projector</li> <li>Methods</li> <li>Video screening</li> <li>Use of multimedia</li> </ul>
Work in pairs	15min.	To practice teamwork skills.  To understand what Internet addiction is and how they can deal with it.	The teacher divides the students in pairs and asks them to discuss about the video and to write down ways that they can fight Internet addiction and regain a balanced life.	<ul><li>Materials</li><li>Pen and paper</li><li>Method</li><li>Work in pairs</li></ul>
Presentation	25min	To practice publish speaking.  To share ideas with the class.	The students present to the class what they wrote down. Each pair has 3-5 minutes depending on the number of the students. The rest of the students can make questions to the pair that is presenting.	<ul><li>Methods</li><li>Work in pairs</li><li>Group discussion</li><li>Presentation</li></ul>
Wrap-up	5 min	To recap the main points.	The teacher summarises the main points discussed.
